

LIST OF ARTICLES NOT INCLUDED IN EPA REGULATION

The rule applies to all articles in hardwood plywood, MDF and particle board and to all goods with parts made of these products. The exceptions concern articles made with NAF and or ULEF.

Here below follows the list of products excluded by EPA:

- Hardboard;
- Structural plywood;
- Structural panels;
- Structural composite lumber;
- Military-specified plywood;
- Curved plywood;
- Oriented strand board;
- Glued laminated lumber;
- Prefabricated wood I-joists;
- Finger-jointed lumber;
- Wood packaging (pallets, crates, spools, dunnage);
- Composite wood products used inside a new vehicle, other than a recreational vehicle, including rail cars, boats and aircraft;
- Windows that contain composite wood products, if the windows contain less than 5% composite wood product by volume;
- Exterior doors and garage doors that contain composite wood products, if:
 - The doors are made from composite wood products manufactured with no-added formaldehyde-based resins or ultra-low-emitting formaldehyde resins; or
 - The doors contain less than 3% composite wood product by volume.
